Rules/Schedule for Visitation of Holy Family Church

The faithful continue to be dispensed from the obligation to participate in Holy Mass at this time. If you have had the Corona Virus you should have been 14 days without symptoms or 2 negative tests before returning to Mass.

IMPORTANT: If you are sick for <u>any</u> reason PLEASE do not come.

No one, clergy or laity should attend Mass if they feel sick.

Holy Family Church will be opened for our normal Masses and social distancing of 6 feet apart per person and a 90 person maximum in the church building must be observed. Social distancing is a must unless living in the same household (families may sit together but MUST all arrive at the same time.) Overflow crowds will be directed to the School gym (also set up for social distancing) for a live-streamed Mass with Holy Communion once capacity is reached. Offertory baskets will not be passed person to person and masks are encouraged to be worn. Ushers, EEM's must wear masks. Use on-line missals if possible as all hymnals and missals have been removed. The Bulletin is available on-line at our web-site. No sign-on the peace will be given by shaking hands. There will be no Precious Blood of our Lord distributed. Communion will be received in the hand only. Dismissal will be directed pew by pew by our ushers. Please no congregating in the vestibule or by the front doors of the church!

Please observe the taped off areas in the church and school and **do not remove the blue tape.** Allow the ushers to direct you and your family to your seats. Let's all be patient and kind!
